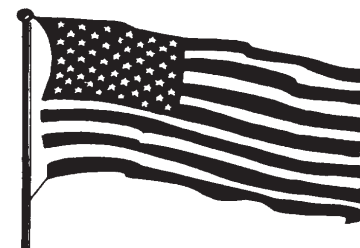

To summarize this past month's activities are as follows:

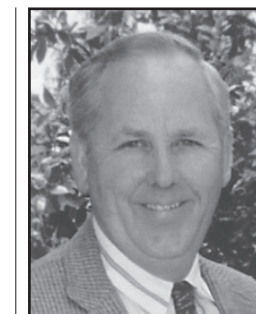

Chaplain's Message

Last month we considered and reflected Corpus Chisti and the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Each helped us to understand the nature of God in Himself: Three Persons and One God, secondly, the Eucharistic Gift - really God and really man united under the appearance of bread and wine, and finally, the feast of the Sacred Heart on the Friday following the feast of Corpus Christi. The first feast of the Trinity reminded us of family united: one for all and all for one. One Family, one Divine nature and three divine perfect persons: Fa-

ther, Son and Holy Spirit.

This is the family we have been destined to participate imperfectly now, but perfectly through graced loved in heaven. The second oneness is that of the Eucharist. Just as Christ is one in Divine Nature and human nature, so too if we eat this bread and drink this cup we become one person both divine and human being before only human, one with Christ human and divine. Lastly, we celebrated the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

If you haven't visited the Knights of Columbus Web site in a while, I encourage you to do so the next time you're online. There are many exciting features on www.kofc.org, but there are two that I wish to make you especially aware of.

The first is our member testimonial area, titled "Stages of Life." In this multi-media area, six "real-life" stories are told – stories of people at different stages of their lives. 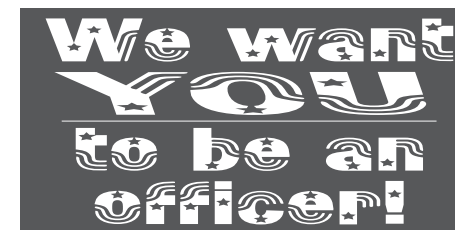
